The 2008-2009 Overall High Point Dog

What is the Overall High Point Dog? Let's start with a little background information. When meeting with several members of the 2007-2008 WCHS Board back in June of 2007, Craig and Teri asked for some creative control in conducting the Series and Invitational. There were two main products of this: the specialty divisions and the Overall High Point Dog award.

Throughout the season, points from the Single and Double Divisions were added together. Specifically, the top combined Singles score (i.e., DOY/BDC score) from each event and the top Doubles score from each event.

Since the Overall High Point Dog can be won by a flusher or pointer, modifications

needed to be made to equalize the scoring. Thus, for the pointers, points were added for each shot bird and 5 seconds were removed from the final run time for each bird in the bag. After the point adjustments were made, the top pointers and flushers were compared.

After each season, the Overall High Point Dog owner will be awarded a traveling trophy. The nameplate will be added and a picture placed in the photo plate. The trophy can be enjoyed for a year as the trophy will be returned following the last regular season tournament.

Hopefully this is a start of a great Wisconsin Series tradition.

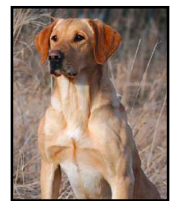
